ADVISORY BOARD RESOLUTIONS

Resolutions properly approved by the Advisory Board shall be presented to the Board of Directors at its next regularly scheduled meeting. At that meeting, the Board may:

- adopt the Resolution as presented;
- reject the Resolution;
- adopt the Resolution in part and reject the Resolution in part, if the Resolution has been presented in reasonably severable subparts; or
- refer the Resolution to a council, committee or task force of the Academy.

If the Board of Directors refers an Advisory Board Resolution to a council, committee or task force of the Academy, the council, committee or task force may recommend that the Board of Directors:

- adopt the Resolution as presented;
- reject the Resolution;
- adopt the Resolution in part and reject the Resolution in part, if the Resolution has been presented in reasonably severable subparts; or
- adopt the Resolution with amendments suggested by the council, committee or task force.

The recommendation of any council, committee or task force to which the Board of Directors has referred an Advisory Board Resolution shall be treated by the Board as any other main motion presented for its consideration by the council, committee or task force.
