

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

MIPS 337: Psoriasis: Tuberculosis (TB) Prevention for Patients with Psoriasis, Psoriatic Arthritis and Rheumatoid Arthritis on a Biological Immune Response Modifier FAQs

Is this measure reportable via claims?

No.

Is the only provider that can report on this measure the provider that prescribed the biologic?

Yes, the physician reporting this measure must be the physician who prescribed the medication.

Can I receive credit for this measure if I do not administer TB tests?

Yes.

How do I receive credit if another provider administered the TB test?

If the TB test is administered by a provider other than the biologic prescriber, confirmation of one of the below mentioned must be obtained via letter or other written means from the administering provider.

- Initials of the clinician that prescribed the biologic
- Initials of the clinician that administered the TB test
- Initials of the clinician that performed the skin test evaluating the result note in the medical record that the results are negative OR that results are positive and is confirmed via results from radiographic imaging
