

Atopic dermatitis/ eczema by the numbers

Atopic dermatitis/eczema is among 24 skin diseases or disease categories examined in the *Burden of Skin Disease* report commissioned by the American Academy of Dermatology. The report examined prevalence, economic burdens, and mortality for skin disease in the U.S. using 2013 health care claims data drawn from insurance enrollment and claims databases and found that:

- **84.5 million** Americans one in four saw a physician for skin disease; 50% of them are over 65 and have an average of 2.2 skin conditions.
- Skin disease **cost the U.S. health care system <u>\$75 billion</u>** in medical, preventative, and prescription and non-prescription drug costs.
- One in three Americans with skin disease were seen by a dermatologist, who collaborate with other physicians throughout the health care system in caring for these patients.

In 2013, atopic dermatitis patients who sought treatment for their disease:

- Totaled more than 3 million Americans.
- Were often young. Nearly half of these patients were children under 18 years old.
- Experienced <u>substantial loss of productivity</u> for themselves and/or their caregivers totaling \$128 million.

The charts that follow provide topline data on how atopic dermatitis contributes to the overall burden of skin disease.










