

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

MIPS 137: Melanoma: Continuity of Care–Recall System FAQs

Does a diagnosis of new melanoma qualify for this measure?

Yes. To qualify for this measure, the patient must have a history of melanoma or a current diagnosis of melanoma.

What if the patient does not show up for their follow-up visit?:

If there is documentation that the patient had a scheduled follow-up appointment and missed it, the measure will qualify, and you will receive credit.

What if the patient does not contact me for their follow-up visit?

If there is documentation of a target date for their next appointment and the patient was contacted in some way to schedule an appointment, the measure will qualify, and you will receive credit.

Do I have to report this measure every time the patient comes back into the office?

No, you only need to report this measure once per reporting period.

Is this measure reportable via claims?

No.
