

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

MIPS 130: Documentation of Current Medications in the Medical Record FAQs

Is this measure reportable via claims?

Yes.

Can my patient call our office back with the information about the dosage, frequency and route of administration for each of their medications?

No, an office visit is needed to be eligible for this measure.

Does a list of current medications need to be updated/documented by the clinician each visit?

Yes, this measure needs to be reported at every eligible encounter.

How are others reporting this measure in their EHR and how do I fulfil the measure if the patient does not have their dosage?

Others document that medications were updated and update the dosages into the medication portion of their EHR.

The patient must list:

- All known prescriptions
- Over-the-counters
- Herbals
- Vitamin/mineral/dietary/nutritional supplements

This includes medication name, dosage, frequency and route of administration. If they are not sure, try to obtain estimates.
