Eczema under control

Skin soft, supple, maybe some dryness

- Bathe (5-10 minutes) in lukewarm water every ______.
- Apply moisturizer to all skin within 3 minutes of finishing bath.
- Apply moisturizer **2 more times** during day to skin that feels dry or often flares.

Eczema flare

Itchy skin with redness or rash

Use your child's medicine and moisturizer (shown below) as often as indicated.

- Apply child's medicine (shown below) to the eczema.
